- ENTRIES: original photography B&W or color, not previously exhibited at Markeim Photographs accepted must be framed and ready to hang. Framed work must not weigh more than 30 lbs
- FEE:Free to submit up to 5 digital images and \$15 fee per image accepted for the exhibition- or no fee for submitted or accepted work for current or new Markeim members
